Energy Savings:

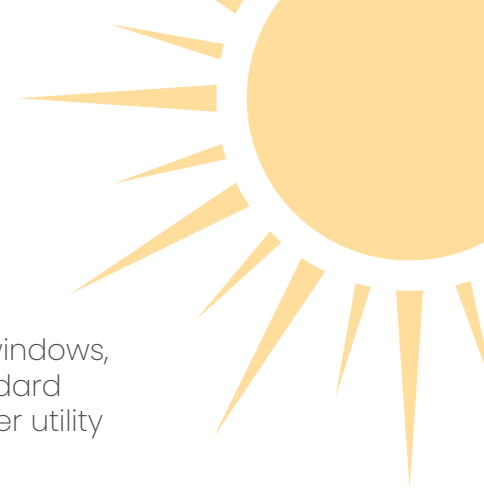
By using high-performance insulation, energy-efficient windows, and airtight construction, homes built to the Vitality standard significantly reduce energy consumption, leading to lower utility bills.
